



#### F2D News - February 2018 Mark Rudner

I don't have much about planes to report this month, but I can share a bit about a little winter project I've been working on (pictures attached). Here's some text to go along with the photos:

I live in a second-floor apartment, and am fortunate to have an extra room that I use as a shop for working on planes. Mostly it's great, but sometimes it stinks. Literally. Especially when I'm soldering, or covering planes. In the summer it's okay-ish to open a window, as long as the wind isn't blowing inward. The wind always blows inward in Denmark.

To get some better ventilation going in the room for situations where I'm making fumes, I decided to make a ventilator that clips into the window next to my work bench. I'm using a bathroom ventilation fan, mounted on a plywood board that clips into the hooks that normally keep the window sealed shut. The fan is connected via a flexible duct to a movable desk lamp that used to have a magnifying lens in it. The lens was just the same size as the 10 cm duct coupler, so I mounted the coupler in the lamp and attached the duct to it with a hose clamp. This allows me to easily position the ventilator over the work, while the light can keep it illuminated.

Overall I think it's going to be a pretty sweet setup. I'm still planning to build a bowl around the lamp to help it collect air from a wider area. The fan feels like it might be a little underpowered. We'll see how it goes. I can always upgrade later if needed. Anyway it was a fun project, and a little breath of fresh air. If someone else out there faces a similar issue, perhaps it can give a little inspiration.






This Beautiful "Slingshot" is from the Mear's Classic Combat Collection
