



F2D News - December 2015

Here we are again, approaching the end of another year. As I mentioned last month, this year we got a special boost right at the end of the F2D season -- the FAI decided to include combat as one of four featured aeromodeling events at the World Air Games in Dubai. I wrote up a report on it for Model Aviation, and since I'm not allowed to duplicate material I'll have to invite you to read the full report there. It was quite an event, though. Control line combat and RC pylon were flown right along side with parachuting competitions, full-scale glider aerobatics, rescue helicopter slalom, and all kinds of other interesting sports.

The scale of the whole event was way beyond anything any of us had ever experienced at a World Championships. There was a huge media presence, with a live feed from the field (also shown on-site on "jumbotron" monitors) and running commentary on the PA system. After the first day a wind storm blew in with 20 mph winds, which obviously made flying quite tough. Nonetheless, the show went on. In that kind of wind you can't expect to see many nice small cuts; combat tends to turn more into a survival game. Despite many quirks, it was all-in-all an interesting experience. When the dust settled, Alex Prokofiev emerged as the first ever World Air Games champion in F2D (and it's not clear when the next will be). Jussi Forss (Finland) took second place, while Rudi Konigshofer (Austria) came in third.

In less than five months we'll be back at it at the World Championships in Perth, Australia. It's a pretty compressed schedule this year, so there's no time to waste for those who will be competing there. In the three days preceding the World Champs there will be an open F2D World Cup (see http://www.cl-ausworldcup2016.org/index.php). If anyone has been thinking about taking a once in a lifetime trip to Australia, now's the time to do it. Kangaroo steaks and combat -- I don't know what could be a better way to spend a warm week in May!


